

ECCCS Dress Code

PREFERED SHOPPING FROM LANDS END



School Uniform Sweater/Outerwear

- **Required:** Sweater/Fleece Jacket – **No Hood** – Burgundy, Navy Blue, Black, or Gray
(can be purchased at Lands End)
 - No other outerwear, including sweatshirts, flannel shirts, etc. will be permitted to be worn in the school building.

Boy Requirements

School Uniform Slacks

- No painter pants or carpenter pants, cords, or stripes

School Uniform Shoes

- Dress shoes permitted
- *Jr. High Only - Slip on dress shoes permitted

Girl Requirements

School Uniform Slacks

- ***Required: Polo Dress or Skirt must be worn on all Chapel days**
- Bike shorts, Skimmies, spandex shorts for under dresses and skirts for modesty
No Capri pants, hip huggers or low risers

School Uniform Socks

- Bare legs are not permitted

School Uniform Shoes

- Heels below 2 ½ inches
- Boots below the knee
- *Jr. High Only - Slip on dress shoes permitted

School Uniform Slacks

- Pants must sit at the waist
- K5 – 4th: Optional – a belt

School Uniform Socks

- No sports socks
- Ankles must be covered

School Uniform Shoes

- Athletic Sneakers are permitted
- Crocs, Sandals, flip-flops, open toed shoes, jellies, and athletic spikes **are NOT permitted.**

N3-K4 Dress Code

N3 and K4 children are not required to wear the ECCCS school uniform. You may however, choose to do so. If you choose to dress your child in an ECCCS uniform please follow the K5-1st grade guidelines.

N3-K4 Everyday clothing and shoes

- No shorts , No Jeans
- Logos should be appropriate for Christian School
- Tie or buckle shoes only, No Velcro or slip on shoes
- Sneakers are permitted
- **Required**-sneakers on Phys. Ed. Days

Girls

- Dresses, pants, and capris may be worn
- Blouses, t-shirts, and sweaters may be worn

***Hoodies jackets or shirts with hoods are NOT permitted.**

***Sandals, flip flops, open toed shoes, jellies, and athletic spikes are NOT permitted**

K5-8th Physical Education Dress Code

Required

1. ECCCS T-Shirt
2. Gray, navy blue, or black sweatpants or “swishies”
3. White crew socks, ankles must be covered
4. Standard athletic shoes (running, basketball, or tennis) **No spikes allowed**



Optional

1. ECCCS Sweatshirt
2. If needed, students may wear a **Hoodless** jacket, windbreaker, or winter coat during **P.E.**
3. * **From Sept-Oct 1st and May 1st- end of school year, students are permitted to wear shorts on gym days* they must be loose fitting, knee length and gray, navy blue, or black. NO spandex or bike shorts.**
 - ❖ Girls may only wear stud earrings on gym days

Miscellaneous Dress Code Rules

Everyone

1. Hair must be kept neat, brushed, and properly trimmed
2. No unnatural hair colors
3. No Hats
4. No extreme hairstyles (Mohawks, gothic styles, streaking, etc.)
5. Nails must be kept short and clean
6. No extreme styles of jewelry, body/facial piercings, or tattoos permitted

BOYS	GIRLS
1. Hair must be kept out of eyes, off shirt collar, and not hang over ears	1. Jr. High girls may wear light makeup, but no extreme make up trends
2. No sharp lines or designs	2. No dark fingernail polish
3. Boys are not to wear makeup or nail polish	3. Earrings must be under ¾ inches
4. No earrings of any kind	4. No large hoops or dangling styles
5. No Bracelets'	5. Only 2 pairs of earrings at one time
6. One thin gold or silver chain allowed	

Special Dress Day Rules



Special Days Dress Code

Jean Day

1. No shorts
2. Jeans must be clean and modest, no rips or tears and should meet our standards in relation to fit and logos 3. Skinny Jeans are not permitted
4. Tops must have logos, pictures, and themes which are appropriate for Christian School
5. Tops must cover waistbands
 - ❖ Girls- tank tops, spaghetti straps, low cut, and see through or sheer tops are not appropriate

Dress Up Day

1. No Jeans or sweats
 - ❖ **Boys-** Dress pants and Dress Shirts, and undershirts are not permitted as a main shirt
 - ❖ **Girls-** Dresses and skirts must be at least knee length ; leggings or spandex pants are not permitted and no heels above 2 ½ inches

Dress Down Day

1. No jeans
2. Sweats and slacks are permitted
3. Tops must have logos, pictures, and themes which are appropriate for Christian school
 - ❖ **Boys-** Undershirts are not permitted as a main shirt
 - ❖ **Girls-** Dresses and skirts must be at least knee length ; leggings or spandex pants are not permitted

Pajama Day

1. Slippers and robes may be worn
2. If PJ Day falls on gym day, students must bring in gym shoes
 - ❖ **Girls-** if a gown is worn it must be dark enough so that it is not see-through, or pants must be worn underneath.

- No shorts are permitted on any special days**
- If not participating students are to wear their uniforms**
- Appropriateness will be determined by administration**
